RE: Public Information Request – Legal and Illegal Alien Voter Registration Forms

Mr. Lauer,

You have requested the following information from the Clark County Election Department:

- 24 month break down of the total number of voter registration forms of legal and illegal aliens submitted to my office from the DMV.
- A month by month break down of the total number of voter registration forms of legal and illegal aliens submitted to my office but not accepted from all sources over the past 24 months.
- The total number of registration forms rejected by my office over the last 24 months broken down month by month.
- The number of legal and illegal aliens purged from the voter rolls over the last 24 months broken down month by month.

We do not have access to any database which can identify legal or illegal aliens in our voter registration system. Therefore, we do not have the ability to provide the records listed in your public information request.

It is the voter's responsibility to verify that they are eligible to vote when they fill out and sign the voter registration affidavit, regardless of where they register to vote. Providing false information on a voter registration affidavit would make the applicant guilty of perjury.

The only time we question the information provided by an applicant, related to citizenship, occurs when they mark "No" they are not a U.S. citizen or when they leave the boxes blank. This results in a follow up letter to the applicant asking them to confirm that they are not a U.S. citizen if they marked "No" or to please indicate that they are a U.S. citizen if they leave the boxes blank. If they respond that they are a U.S. citizen the voter is made active in our system, if they do not respond or they indicate that they are not a U.S. citizen within 30 days of mailing the notice to them their record is canceled from the system.

Based on this explanation I can provide you with a listing of applicants who marked "No" on their voter registration affidavit or left the boxes blank over the past 24 months. If you wish for us to provide this listing there will be a charge of \$80.33 to have one of our programmers generate the listing and put it

into an Excel spreadsheet for you to review. This is the only listing we are able to produce that might satisfy your request. Please let me know if you want us to move forward with producing the listing.
