To Whom It May Concern,

Under the Nevada Open Records Act (NRS.239), we are requesting an opportunity to obtain copies of any and all public records in whatever medium they may be, regarding any and all communications of any kind, memorandum or other public records of any kind whatsoever between

Please provide: All Documentation that CCAD is in full compliance with NRS 394.1688 Annual review and update of plan for responding to crisis or emergency; maintenance, posting and distribution of plan; annual training for school employees.

- 1. Each development committee shall, at least once each year, review and update as appropriate the plan that it developed pursuant to NRS 394.1687. In reviewing and updating the plan, the development committee shall consult with the director of the local organization for emergency management or, if there is no local organization for emergency management, with the Chief of the Division of Emergency Management of the Department of Public Safety or his or her designee.
- 2. Each development committee shall provide an updated copy of the plan to the governing body of the school.

- 3. The governing body of each private school shall:
- (a) Post a notice of the completion of each review and update that its development committee performs pursuant to subsection 1 at the school;

## Evidence that CCSD has complied with NRS 394.1688 in 2016, 2017.

(h) At least once each year, provide training in responding to a crisis and training in responding to an emergency to each employee of the school, including, without limitation, training concerning drills for evacuating and securing the school.

It is intended that this request encompass any and all public records in the control of the Clark County School District for each school, of its staff may obtain, which relate in any way to the above subject and/or situation. It is asked that this request be considered in the broadest possible way allowed under Nevada law.

If there are any fees for searching or copying these records, please inform me if the cost will exceed \$25.00. However, we would also like to request a waiver of all fees in that the disclosure of the requested information is in the public interest and will contribute significantly to the public's understanding of the issues addressed in this letter.

Specifically, as a news organization, we ask for any and all public records subject to NRS 239.0105(1) which are applicable to the above request. This request should be considered in the broadest possible way allowed under Nevada law.

If access to the records we are requesting will take longer than a 'reasonable' amount of time, please contact me with information about when we might expect copies or the ability to inspect the requested records.

If you deny any or all of this request, please cite each specific exemption you feel justifies the refusal to release the information and notify me of the appeal procedures available to me under the law.
