The undersigned makes the following declarations subject to the penalty of perjury and says: That I am a peace officer with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department, Clark County, Nevada, being so employed for a period of approximately 2 year(s).

That I learned the following facts and circumstances which lead me to believe that the above named subject committed or was committing the offenses above at the location of 3300 FLAMINGO RD E LAS VEGAS NEVADA 89121 and that the offense(s) occurred at approximately 12:28 hours on the 9th day of October, 2021.

Details for Probable Cause:

On 10/09/21 at 1228 hours, Officers were dispatched to an assault/battery with a gun call at 3300 E. Flamingo Rd at the Ichabod bar and lounge. The initial details of the call stated that one person was shot in the abdomen. Upon officers arrival, they located the victim, Paul Laramie in the parking lot of Ichabod lounge, laying on the ground with a gunshot wound to his abdomen. Laramie was transported to Sunrise hospital. The suspect was gone prior to officer arrival. One 9mm casing was located in the parking lot. While officers were still at the scene, dispatch received a call from a person identifying himself as the person who shot Laramie at 3300 E. Flamingo Rd. The person calling identified himself verbally as Nathan Hendershot. Sgt. Donovan P# 13241 established contact with Hendershot via phone. Sgt. Donovan and officers coordinated with Hendershot and met with him at 4480 Pecos Rd. Hendershot was placed in handcuffs and detained without incident.

Detective C. Richardson P# 14739 and Detective R. Steinbach P# 13989 responded to the scene. Detective Richardson interviewed witness Darwin Castillo. Castillo advised he had pulled into the parking lot of Ichabod lounge to pick someone up. He observed two males in what appeared to be a verbal argument. Castillo recalled the suspect, Hendershot had a red t-shirt on. Castillo heard a gunshot and saw a male lying on the ground. He saw Hendershot get into a light colored sedan and drive off. Castillo advised he briefly followed the vehicle and was able to get the plate of the vehicle. He then returned to the scene and waited for officers to arrive.

Detectives reviewed video surveillance of the incident and observed Laramie and Hendershot in the parking lot near a light colored sedan. They exchanged words and Laramie is observed taking off a jacked and putting both arms out to his side in a 'T' position. Hendershot opened the driver side door briefly and closed it. A flash is seen, and Laramie fell to the ground. Laramie did not have any weapon in his hands when Hendershot shot him. Hendershot got into his vehicle and drove away.

Detectives went to 4480 Pecos Rd and interviewed Hendershot. Hendershot advised that he was at the bar when Laramie walked in. He heard an unusual sound and then heard Laramie mention a pepper ball gun. Hendershot stated that a while

later he got food from the bar 'to go' and exited the bar. Hendershot stated he observed Laramie outside conversing with another subject but upon exiting, Laramie struck up a conversation with him. Hendershot advised that he told Laramie to leave him alone but that Laramie followed him to his vehicle. Hendershot mentioned that Laramie began to discuss his pepper ball gun with him and asked Hendershot to shoot him with it but Hendershot declined and stated he was trying to leave. Laramie became upset and began to insult Hendershot. Hendershot stated that he believed Laramie was trying to cause him harm, so he told Laramie that he had a firearm. Laramie did not appear concerned by this information and insulted Hendershot again. Laramie took off his jacket and Hendershot stated he was in fear for his personal safety, so he grabbed his firearm from the driver side door. Hendershot stated he observed a shoulder rig holster on Laramie with the pepper ball gun holstered. More words were exchanged and Hendershot fired one round into Laramie's abdomen.

Hendershot advised the firearm was back at his residence located at 4571 Kenmare Way. When detectives advised that they would need to retrieve the firearm, he became uncooperative and would not advise where the firearm was.

Laramie did not advance on Hendershot and did not remove the pepper ball gun from the holster during the incident. Detectives determined that there was probable cause to arrest Hendershot for Battery With a Deadly Weapon. Due to the fact that Hendershot did use force or violence against the person of Laramie by firing his firearm once, striking Laramie in the abdomen, Hendershot was arrested for Battery With a Deadly Weapon. Hendershot was transported to Clark County Detention Center, and was booked accordingly.

Detective Richardson obtained a search warrant which was approved by Judge Dela Garza, to recover the firearm and obtain a buccal swab of Hendershot. The search warrant authorized a search for both Hendershot's residence and vehicle. The firearm was located in Hendershot's vehicle bearing NV plate 417M62, in the garage. The firearm recovered was a Glock 19 9mm and an extra magazine.
